How BTT created a sustainable future for Khiphinkunzi Primary School in the midst of the covid-19 pandemic!

- The classrooms of Khiphinkunzi Primary School in Mtubatuba were dilapidated and overcrowded leading to a high learner to teacher ratio. This posed a risk of increase in COVID-19 transmissions and negatively impacted the learners academic performance in school.
- BTT sponsored the funding of five new classrooms through Nontu Mgabhi's project- 'Go Beyond for a Child'
- The new classrooms were finally completed and ready for handover in April 2021.
